TIME LIMIT - 1700 hrs

Start Line: A line will be formed by the Transit of the  
Leading marks on Sandhill Point and the Poundstone  
bearing 360°.

The outer distance mark will be a Committee  
Boat, (a volunteer or chosen by lot). The start line is to be  
crossed west to east. Race Start countdown will be in  
accordance with SI 3.5 and SI 5.1.2. The Committee Boat  
shall be given a 5 minute allowance.

Course: From Start Line, proceed to finish, leaving  
Blackstone Rocks to Port.

Finish Line: Between the RDYC flagstaff at Blackstone  
Point and the Castle Ledge Buoy (to be left to starboard).  
The line is to be crossed south west to north east

Finish Times : Self timing .

Course B: If Board or Flag ' C ' is displayed at Battery Point.

From start line ' R ' , leave marks Skerries Buoy to Port, Finish at ' R ' as per SI 7.1 \*

#### **July 19th ( Monday ) – RNLI RACE**

Races : One

This is a “ Fun” fund raising race in aid of RNLI, Each Brixham yacht must carry a member (aged under 18) of Brixham Junior Sailing as part of its working crew. Each Visitor yacht must carry a member (aged under 18 ) of their Club' s Junior or Cadet organisation (or similar). If for any reason this is not possible, the Race Committee must be advised prior to going on the water and an additional sum of £5 paid. There may also be a time or placing penalty at the discretion of the Race Committee.

The Race will be run from a Committee Boat, unless flag G is displayed at the Clubhouse mast, in which case it will be run from Battery Point. Note that flags and sound signals may be unusual and not in accordance with RRS. This will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 60.1 a)

Course : A special course will be laid that will be notified on VHF Ch 37A(M)

**August 5th ( Thursday ) – LADIES RACE**

Qualification : The helm throughout the race is required to be a female. If for any reason the boat is helmed by a male crew member, even if only temporarily, this must be declared to the Race Committee who may at their discretion impose a penalty

TIME LIMIT - all classes - 1810 hrs

ALL boats are required to take their own time when rounding Exe Fairway Buoy and it bears 360° M. If no boat finishes in that class, this time will be used to time the race, if any boat in the class has attained it. This changes SI 8.6

Start line for courses A , B & C At Battery Point in accordance with SI 5.2.2

Course A: If board or flag A is displayed at Battery Point.

From start line leave marks ' F' , Exe Fairway Buoy and mark R, all to port, then proceed to finish.

Course B: If board or flag B is displayed at Battery point.

From start line leave marks ' F' , Teign Sewer Outfall Buoy and mark R, all to port then proceed to finish.

Finish line for courses A and B: At Mark ' G' leaving it to port cross the line North-West to South-East as per SI 7.1 \*

Course C: If board or flag ' C' is displayed at Battery Point.

A club course will be sailed in accordance with SI 4

Note \* : Unless SI 7.2 applies
